Beginning for Lot No. 24, at the corner of Main Street in said village and a 15 foot alley and running with said alley, N. 50 1/4 degrees E. 7 1/2 perches, still with said alley, N. 62 1/2 degrees E. 9 1/2 perches to the end of another alley, thence along last mentioned alley, N. 49 1-4 degrees N. 6 perches to Lot No. 23, then with Lot No. 23 to Main Street, thence with Main Street, S. 40 1/2 degrees E. 57 feet to the beginning.
