

Mary Regina Diller, a witness of lawful age, produced on behalf of the Plaintiff, being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

Q. Miss Diller, will you state your full name, please?

A. Mary Regina Diller.

Q. And your address?

A. Libertytown, Maryland.

Q. Your age?

A. Sixty-five.

Q. And your occupation?

A. None. I am retired.

Q. Are you a relative of Robert H. Diller?

A. Yes.

Q. What is that relationship?

A. I am a sister.

Q. Is Mr. Diller living?

A. No, he is not.

Q. When did he die?

A. August 18, 1964.

Q. Testate or intestate?

A. Testate.

A. Yes.

Q. Have you qualified in that capacity?

A. Yes, I have.

Q. I show you "Exhibit B" filed in these proceedings. Will you examine, and state whether or not that is a copy of Letters Testamentary issued to you as Executrix by the Orphans Court for Frederick County, Maryland, in connection with Mr. Diller's Estate?
