2. That a Guardian Ad Litem may be appointed to answer on behalf of the said infant defendant.

3. That your Complainants may have such other and further relief as the nature of their case may require.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants the Writ of Subpoena directed to the said Loretta P. Crum, widow, who resides at Walkersville, Maryland, Easter M. Kettells and Warren Kettells, her husband, who reside at Walkersville, Maryland, Marguerite Crum, widow, Harry C. Crum, unmarried and Demaris G. Crum, unmarried infant, all residing at Walkersville, Maryland, commanding them, and each of them, to be and appear either in person or by Solicitor, in this Court, on or before a certain day, to be named therein, to show cause, if any they have why a Decree ought not be passed as prayed.


