

said property through this period of time.

TENTH: That by virtue of the foregoing, a question has been raised as to whether your Orators have a good and marketable title to said premises, and although your Orators claim to hold a valid fee simple title, the same cannot be established of record with the removal of the aforesaid claim upon the title of your Orators; that your Orators have no adequate remedy at law.

TO THE END, THEREFORE:

1. That your Honorable Court <sup>MAY</sup> take jurisdiction in the premises and enter a Decree quieting title to the real estate mentioned and described in this Bill of Complaint and remove the cloud from the title thereof.
2. That this Court shall declare that your Orators have a good and marketable fee simple title to the property mentioned in the Bill of Complaint and may sell or convey or otherwise deal with such property without regard to the claims of the unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives, descendants or successors of Sarah Brooks, deceased.
3. That this Court shall pass an Order of Publication according to law, requiring the unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives, descendants or successors of Sarah Brooks, deceased, to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be named in said Order, to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.
4. That your Orators may have such other and further relief as the nature of their case may require.


