FOURTH: That being so seized and possessed of said tract or parcel of land, the said Minnie C. Fry Earhart, died testate in Frederick County, Maryland, on or about the 30th day of September, 1963, as aforesaid. Her Will being probated and admitted to record in Liber T.M.E. No. 3, Folio 24, one of the Will Records of Frederick County, Maryland, a Certified Copy of which Will is filed herewith and prayed to be taken as a part hereof and marked Exhibit "E".

FIFTH: That said last Will and Testament provided in part as follows:

Item 4. "Of the rest and residue of my property and estate, I give, devise and bequeath one-third thereof to my husband, Abraham Earhart."
