Donaldson and Betty Jane Donaldson, his wife, executed a note to Loyola Federal Savings and Loan Association, a body corporate, for the sum of Twenty Nine Thousand Four Hundred Dollars, (\$29400.00) as evidenced by their promisory note of said date for said sum of money, payable unto the said Loyola Federal Savings and Loan Association, a body corporate, or order and at the same time did execute a Deed of Trust in which Sam W. Borden and Charles J. Fleury were named as Trustees, which Deed of Trust was recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County in Liber No. 728, Folio 225 and by which Deed of Trust the said Lawver and Donaldson, Inc., a body corporate, Norman E. Lawver and Judy Lawver, his wife, and Walter L. Donaldson and Betty Jane Donaldson, his wife, conveyed unto the said Trustees for the benefit of the holder of said Note all the following lots or parcels of land situate, lying and being in Frederick County, State of Maryland, particularly described as follows:
