

2. That the Court may enjoin the defendants from entering upon said lots or interfering with the Petitioners' quiet enjoyment thereof.

3. And for such other and further relief as the nature of the Petitioners' case may require.

Your Petitioners further pray that an Order of Publication may be passed by your Honorable Court, to be published in some newspaper in Frederick County, giving notice to Wilbur K. Hammaker and Jacqueline B. Hammaker, his wife, and commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court in person or by solicitor on some certain date named therein, and show cause, if any they have, why the relief prayed for should not be granted.
