

Q And are you licensed in the State of Maryland?

A I am.

Q From what date?

A 1962.

Q You are a graduate of an engineer school?

A Gettysburg College.

Q How long has that been?

A 1932.

Q You have been a member of the engineering profession.....?

A 28 years.

Q How long have you been involved in work relating to the surveying profession?

A Covering that period. Intermittently covering that period.

Q Mr. Hershey, I show you a plat and ask you if you can identify this?

A This is Tract 1 of the Carrie Dern Estate located in Emmitsburg District, Frederick County, Maryland.

Q Did you survey this land?

A I did.

Q When did you make that survey?

A I made the survey over a the period from the 16th of January to the 1st of February, 1967.

Q Was the fieldwork done by you?

A It was.

Q And did you prepare this plat?

A I did.

Q How many acres are in this farm land?

A 231.1571.

Q How were the boundaries established?

A They were established by.....there was a series of things. We had in our possession the deed of Robert Grimes, generally land to the south and also we had the deed of Joe D. Wivell and that was land to the south there and also the deed of George Martin estate, a portion of that to the north. I have shown also on the northeastern portion of the plat the property owner is Vergie Ohler but there was no legal deeds to that and since there is a line in there it has been accepted by both property owners for over 20 years and the boundary was established from that.
