Q. I show you the reverse part of this document, marked "Exhibit A", which reads "Assignment", can you identify it?

A. Yes.

Q. Mr. and Mrs. Furry assigned all their right, title and interest to you?

A. That is right.

Q. How much money has been paid unto Charlotte W. Yarroll as of this time?

A. \$21.39.

Q. Referring to Ruth E. Weller, she is deceased?

A. Yes.

Q. Did you know any of her relatives, or did you know anyone who knew any of her relatives?

A. No I didn't. I never talked to anyone.
