

- Q. What is the name of Mr. Kepler's other son?
- A. Arthur K. Kepler.
- Q. Is he living now?
- A. No, he and his wife are both dead.
- Q. Did they leave any children surviving?
- A. No.
- Q. You indicated earlier in your testimony that Mrs. Doub left surviving a brother by the name of Charles L. Kepler. Is he now living?
- A. No, he is deceased.
- Q. Did he leave any heirs surviving?
- A. His wife, and a son, Merle. His widow's name is Annie C. Kepler, and she lives at Middletown, Maryland. The son, Merle C. Kepler, also lives at Middletown, and he is married to Catherine M. S. Kepler.
- Q. You also mentioned earlier that Mrs. Doub had a brother by the name of Alonza C. Kepler. Is he living?
- A. No.
- Q. By whom was he survived?
- A. By his widow, Bessie Kepler, who is now deceased, and one son, Leland M. Kepler, who is married to Helen Kepler, and they now resid at Boca Raton, Florida.
- Q. To your knowledge, are there any other persons in Mrs. Doub's line which have not been mentioned in your testimony?
- A. To my knowledge, no.
- Q. Again, to the best of your knowledge and belief, are all of the heirs-at-law of the late George L. Doub aforementioned sui juris?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Turning now, Miss Kefauver, to the improvements known as 201-205 West Main Street in Middletown, Maryland, will you indicate generally what the physical condition of these improvements is?
- A. They are presently unoccupied, and have been so, except for storage, since 1958. The garages have been occupied until
