

said property caused the title of said real estate to ripen in the said Gerald J. Schipper by adverse possession.

(7) That the above matter constitutes a cloud upon the title of your Complainant and although your Complainant claims to hold a valid fee simple title, the same cannot be established of record without removal of aforesaid cloud upon the title of your Complainant; that your Complainant has no adequate remedy at law.

TO THE END THEREFORE:

WHEREFORE, your Complainant prays for the following relief:

1. That an adjudication be made that the Complainant is the absolute fee simple owner of the property described herein with the right of disposition thereof.

2. That an Order of Publication be issued by this Honorable Court ordering the Defendants in this cause to show cause, if any they have, why a decree as aforesaid should not be passed.

3. And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.
