Bill of Complaint To Foreclose Equity of Redemption

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

First: That a Certificate of Sale, No. 287, was on the 14th day of November, 1966, issued unto James F. Gibson and Catherine D. Gibson, by Charlotte W. Yarroll, County Treasurer, Collector of Taxes for the State of Maryland and the County of Frederick, Maryland, which Certificate of Sale is attached hereto as Exhibit No.1, and along with all other Exhibits prayed to be taken as a part hereof.

Second: A description of the property appearing on the collector's tax roll is "3 1/2 acres Bk. Church On Gapland Rd. " and being the same lot or parcel of land conveyed unto Ernest Weems and Cora Weems, his wife, by deed dated the 9th day of November, 1944, by Sherman P.
