PETITION TO PUBLISH NOTICE TO CREDITORS

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of William W. Wenner and W. Jerome Offutt, Trustees in the within cause, respectfully represents unto your Honors:

1. That by a Decree passed in these proceedings on the 10th day of August, 1967 in this Honorable Court, your Petitioners were duly appointed Trustees to make sale of the real estate in these proceedings described and set forth.

2. That your Petitioners, as Trustees, have lately discovered that James Denton Allgire one of the tenants in common in whom the real estate had vested, died on or about October 5, 1966 intestate and that no letters of Administration has been granted on his said Estate, which appears to be only an interest in the real estate mentioned in these proceedings; further, that a certain Holmes William Allgire, brother of the said James Denton Allgire, was a tenant in common of said real estate and the he died, intestate, on or about the 19th day of November, 1963, and no Letters of Administration had been granted on his said Estate, which appears to be only an interest in the real estate mentioned in these proceedings.

3. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 124, Article 93, of the Annotated Code of Maryland, 1957, as amended, this Honorable Court may Decree a Notice providing for at least ninety (90) days Notice to Creditors, which Notice shall be in lieu of the Notice required in the Orphans' Court for Frederick County.
