PETITION FOR  
DECREE PRO CONFESSO

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Della Liday and Charles D. Walters, Jr. by William R. Leckemby, Jr., their solicitor, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

FIRST: That on or about the 26th day of September, 1968, your Petitioners filed their Bill of Complaint herein and on the same day an order was entered herein directing that your Petitioners, by causing a copy of such order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County, Maryland, once a week, in each of four successive weeks, the last of such publications to be made not less than thirty (30) days before the 3rd day of December, 1968, give notice to the unknown heirs, devisees, personal representatives, descendants or successors of Dr. W.
