

FIFTH: That the estate of the said Edward J. Smith consists of $1\frac{1}{2}$ acres of land, more or less, situate, lying and being on Bowers Road near Mountindale, Frederick County, Maryland, improved with a dwelling thereon, which dwelling has no conveniences other than electricity and water secured from an outside pump, and that the said Edward J. Smith is also seized and possessed of an adjoining unimproved woodlot containing five acres, more or less, all for an aggregate market value of \$ 5810.00; that the said Edward J. Smith is the owner of a Savings Account in his individual name in the Fredericktown Savings and Trust Company in the amount of \$9,131.04; that the said Edward J. Smith is the owner of a joint Savings Account in his name and in the name of Inez R. Coleman, as joint tenants, in the amount of \$4,334.39; and the said Edward J. Smith is the owner of a joint Checking Account located in the Farmers and Mechanics National Bank, Frederick, Maryland, in his name and in the name of Inez R. Coleman in the amount of \$2,565.21; and that the said Edward J. Smith is the owner of certain household effects located in his home near Mountindale, Frederick County, Maryland for an approximate value of \$ 100.⁰⁰.

SIXTH: That the alleged incompetent is unable by reason of mental and physical disabilities to endorse checks and to issue checks in order to pay his outstanding bills including current bills at the Frederick Nursing and Convalescent Center, Frederick, Maryland.

SEVENTH: That your Petitioners believe that it would be to the best interest and advantage of the said Edward J. Smith that a Committee or Trustees be appointed to manage the property and estate of the said Edward J. Smith and that they be appointed Committee or Trustees to manage the property and estate of the alleged incompetent.

WHEREFORE YOUR PETITIONERS PRAY:

1. That your Honorable Court will appoint a Committee or Trustees to take charge of and manage the property and estate of the said Edward J. Smith.
