DECREE

The above cause standing ready for hearing and being submitted on the Petition, Affidavit thereto and Exhibits, it is thereupon this 10th day of June, 1968, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED, that Edward J. Smith be, and he is, hereby declared to be incompetent to manage his person and estate, and Inez R. Coleman and Virginia Ilgenfritz be, and they are hereby appointed, Committee, to take charge of and manage the estate of the said Edward J. Smith, and that the course of their proceeding shall be as follows:

They shall first execute a Corporate Bond to the State of Maryland with good and sufficient security to be approved by this Court of the Clerk thereof in the penalty of \$ Two Thousand conditioned that the said Inez R. Coleman and Virginia Ilgenfritz, as Committee aforesaid, will faithfully discharge their duties as such Committee of the said Edward J. Smith, and deliver up the said Edward J. Smith's property whenever they may be required by the Order of the Court so to do, and it is further ORDERED that the said Inez R. Coleman and Virginia Ilgenfritz, as Committee, return to this Court, an inventory specifically setting forth all the property, real and personal, belonging to the estate of the said Edward J. Smith.

It is ORDERED that the said Inez R. Coleman and Virginia Ilgenfritz, as such Committee, shall have the right to spend all the income they receive as ^{and invade the principal} Committee for Board, Room, Medical Care, and
