1. That your Complainants are children and heirs of Walter S. Bidle and Vergie G. Bidle, his wife.
2. That the Defendants are the wife and surviving children of Walter S. Bidle, Jr., deceased son of Walter S. Bidle and Virgie G. Bidle.
3. That all of the parties to this action are sui juris except Cheryl Ann Bidle who is 20 years old being born February 19, 1952.
4. That Walter S. Bidle, Widower, died intestate on or about May 16, 1966, with no estate of record.
5. That the said Walter S. Bidle died seized and possessed of the following real property, namely, all those tracts or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the Jackson Election District, Frederick County, State of Maryland, and more particularly described as follows:

All that tract or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in Frederick County, State of Maryland, on the road leading from Koogle's School House to Lutz' Mill, about one mile south of Harmony, containing in the aggregate 93 acres and 19 square perches of land, more or less, and being all and the same parcels of land as conveyed by Ralph I. Brandenburg and Grace E. Brandenburg in a deed dated March 24, 1917,
