

cel; and the appraised value of the four acre parcel is 81.191% of the total of the appraised values of both parcels. The Petitioner suggests to the Court that, if the Court sees fit to approve the proposed sale, 81.191% of the net proceeds of the sale be invested as the Court may deem most advantageous to Florence K. West, and in such a way as to show that Florence K. West is the owner of a life interest in such investment, and your Petitioner is the owner of the remainder.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner prays:

1. That this Honorable Court may decree that the sale reported above be confirmed and that the Petitioner be authorized and directed, upon receipt of the purchase price in full, to convey the life estate of Florence K. West to the purchasers.

2. And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.
