

FIFTH: That there is filed herewith a statement from Charlotte W. Yarroll, County Treasurer and Collector of Taxes for Frederick County, State of Maryland, showing the amount of money necessary to redeem said property and said statement being herewith filed as "Exhibit C" and is prayed to be taken as a part hereof by this reference.

SIXTH: To the end therefore:

1. That a final decree may be passed by your Honorable Court foreclosing all rights of redemption of the Respondants.
2. That the County Treasurer of Frederick County, Maryland be directed to prepare and execute a deed in fee simple unto Christine Lynn Pruitt, as Assignee, upon payment of the purchase price of the property herein described in full, together with all taxes, interest and penalties accruing subsequent to the date of sale.
3. And for such other further relief as the case may require.

May it please your Honorable Court to grant onto the Complainant an Order of Publication giving notice to all persons, known and unknown, and whether resident or non-resident of the State of Maryland, having or claiming to have any interest in the property described as aforesaid and assessed in the name of Richard W. Harbaugh, commanding them and each of them to appear in this Court on or before a date certain to be named therein, not less than sixty (60) days from the date of the filing of this Bill of Complaint and to answer said Bill of Complaint or to redeem said property and warning each of them that upon their failure to do so, a final decree will be rendered for closing all rights of redemption in the said property; and also that a Writ of Subpoena be issued directed to the said Charlotte W. Yarroll, County Treasurer and Collector of Taxes for Frederick County, State of Maryland, commanding her to be and appear in this Court in person or by solicitor, on or before a date certain to be named therein, not less than sixty (60) days from
