

A Yes, that is correct.

Court: What is the age of the daughter?

A Which one?

Court: Yvonne? Is she over 21?

A I can't remember . . .

Court: If you don't know, answer I don't know.

A I don't know.

Q Directing your attention to Jesse N. Smith, what is his condition and mentally and physically to look after his estate/property properly?

A He is incapable of doing it because of his mental condition.

Q How long generally has Mr. Smith been in this present mental condition?

A As far as I know it has been quite a few years. And talking to one of his doctors to having him committed to Springfield, Dr. Conley, he says definitely he has been showing worse signs since 1964.

Q But as far as you personally know?

A As far as I know he has been showing signs I would say since four to five years.

Q Now, in the Petition, you have filed as Exhibit 1 through Exhibit 7, deeds to properties which Mr. Smith owns at the present time. Are these all of his properties to your knowledge that he owns?

A As far as the knowledge that I know the properties that you have stated is all that I know of that he owns. Because the reason why is we have been living in Baltimore and he lives in Frederick and we haven't had close contact with him and he never would talk business to me even when I come up and visited him.

Q As the land records show from what you have determined from that investigation, these are the properties that you have any knowledge of?

A Yes, that is true.

Q We offer into evidence Exhibits 1 through 7 which are deeds to the respective tracts or parcels of lands that he owns.

Court: All right; mark them please.

Q Now, Mr. Smith, you have alleged in para. 6 certain items. First, to a savings account in the Farmers' & Mechanics Bank registered in his name and the present principal sum of \$3,000.. Is that one of his items of assets?
