

ratification of such sale by the Court, and on payment of the whole purchase money, and not before, the said Committee, by a good and sufficient deed, to be executed and acknowledged agreeably to law, shall convey to the purchaser or purchasers of the said property, and to his, her or their heirs, or to it and its successors, the property to him, her, them or it sold free, clear and discharged of all claim of the parties to this cause, and of any person or persons, firm or firms claiming by, from, or under them; and the said Committee shall bring into this Court the money arising on such sale, to be disposed of under the direction of this Court, after deducting therefrom the costs of this proceeding and such commission to said Committee as the Court shall think proper to allow, on consideration of the skill, attention and fidelity where with it shall appear to have discharged its trust.
