PETITION FOR SUPPLEMENTAL DECREE

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of FRED R. McCRUMB, JR., Plaintiff, by Roland R. Bounds, and Bounds and Short, his attorneys, and of GLORIA E. McCRUMB, Defendant, by James Willard Davis and Dulany and Davis, her attorneys, respectfully represents:

1. That on August 30, 1974, Plaintiff filed a Bill of Complaint petitioning this Honorable Court to appoint trustees to make a sale of 25.101 acres of improved land in the Linganore Election District of Frederick County, Maryland, owned by Plaintiff and Defendant as tenants in common.

2. That on September 16, 1974, Defendant filed her Answer to said Bill of Complaint in which she sought the same relief requested by Plaintiff in his Bill of Complaint.

3. That on September 20, 1974, after a hearing, presentation of an appraisal and testimony, this Honorable Court passed its Order appointing Roland R. Bounds and James Willard Davis trustees to make sale of said property.

4. That the public sale of the aforesaid property has been scheduled for 4:00 o'clock p.m. on Thursday, October 24, 1974, on the premises; that the required bond has been filed with the Clerk of this Honorable Court; and that the required notice of said sale in Frederick County, as well as extensive advertising elsewhere, has been completed.

5. That since passage of said Order, Plaintiff and Defendant have requested said Trustees to withdraw said property from public auction and to sell the property at private sale, in the event no bids are received at said auction for One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$140,000.00) or more for the purchase of the aforesaid property; that there are attached hereto consents to the terms of such withdrawal from sale, as follows, viz:
