

KENNETH V. GORDON, one of the Plaintiffs, produced on his own behalf, after having first been duly sworn by me, deposes and says:

Q. Will you state your full name, your age and your residence please?

A. Kenneth V. Gordon, age 55, 1029 Cooks Lane, Baltimore, Maryland 21229.

Q. And you are one of the Complainants in this proceeding?

A. Yes sir.

(BY: Mr. Wenner)

Q. Mr. Gordon, how long have you been in title to the property in question?

A. Since 1955.

Q. And from whom did you acquire the property?

A. John P. Norris and his wife, Alice Norris.

Q. And was that by a deed

A. Oh now wait a minute now, I got this lot from Charles Norris.

Q. Charles Norris?

A. That's right.

Q. And Evelyn his wife?

A. Yes.

Q. And was that by a deed dated July 8, 1955, and recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, in Liber 549, Book 188?

A. Yes sir.

Q. And that is the deed, a copy of which was filed with the Bill of Complaint in this case and marked "Complainant's Exhibit A", is that correct?

A. That's right.

(Mr. Wenner: We enter the deed from Charles R. Norris and Evelyn M. Norris, his wife, to Kenneth D. Gordon and Mary Frances Gordon, his wife, dated July 8, 1955, and recorded in Liber 549, Folio 188 into evidence as Complainant's Exhibit 1.)

Q. And you have owned that lot ever since?

A. Yes sir.

Q. Has anyone to your knowledge ever made any claim to the lot other than yourself?
