

At the request of Ezra Houck the  
following Deed was recorded  
January 26th 1857

This Deed made this twenty second day of January in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty seven by John M. Buck and E. Emma Buck his wife of the City of Baltimore in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that in consideration of Eighteen thousand Six hundred dollars the said John M. Buck and E. Emma Buck his wife, do grant unto Ezra Houck of the City of Frederick, in the County of Frederick and State aforesaid, all the following described pieces or parcels of lands in Frederick County aforesaid to wit. The following described parcel of land, being part of "Taskers Chance" Beginning at a stone standing on the North side of Tuscarora Creek and near its mouth & running thence North fifty one and one fourth degrees East seventeen perches to a stone near Monocy then down with the meanders thereof South thirty five & a half degrees East twenty eight perches, South twenty eight and one fourth degrees East thirteen perches, South twelve degrees East ten perches, South thirty and one fourth degrees East fifty six perches, South fifteen and three fourth degrees East sixteen perches, South two degrees West twenty seven perches to the end of the first line of a deed from John Stoner to Thomas Derr dated March 15, 1817 then with the second line thereof South fifty degrees West thirty three and three fourth perches then South Seventy nine & a half degrees West one hundred ninety four and three fourths perches then South fifty nine & a half degrees West forty five and three tenths perches to Moses Wormans land, thence North forty eight & three fourth degrees West thirty nine and Seventenths perches to a stone North forty nine degrees East two hundred fourteen and a half perches to a stone, North fifty four degrees East nineteen & a half perches to a stone North fifty nine degrees East forty seven perches to the beginning
