

Frederick County, State of Maryland, sold by the Collector of Taxes for the County of Frederick and the State of Maryland to the Complainant in this proceeding:

All that tract or parcel of ground situate in the City of Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland, beginning for the same at a point on the south side of A Street 50 feet east of the east side of First Avenue, and running thence easterly along the south side of A Street 50 feet, thence southerly parallel to First Avenue 150 feet to the north side of a forty-foot alley, thence westerly along the north side of said alley 50 feet, and thence northerly parallel to First Avenue 150 feet to the place of beginning; and being all and the same real estate which was conveyed unto Edward L. Compton by deed from The Real Estate and Improvement Company of Baltimore City, dated May 8, 1894, and recorded in Liber JLJ 7, folio 227, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland.

The Bill states, among other things, that the amount necessary for redemption has not been paid, although more than a year and a day from the date of sale has expired.

It is thereupon this 26th day of November, 1974, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, ORDERED that notice be given by the insertion of a copy of this Order in some newspaper having a general circulation in Frederick County, Maryland, once a week for three successive weeks, warning all persons interested in the said property to be and appear in this Court by the 20th day of January, 1975, and redeem the property and answer the Bill or thereafter a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the property and vesting in the Complainant a title, free and clear of all encumbrances.
