4. All money remaining in my estate after the payment of my just debts and expenses, to be invested and the interest therefrom together with the interest of any securities I may possess, to be shared equally by my sisters, Catherine M. Watkins and Martha I. Watkins, during their life, and at the death of either sister, the surviving sister to receive both shares during her life, At the death of my sisters, Catherine M. Watkins and Martha I. Watkins the balance of my estate to be equally divided among my surviving brothers and sisters.

5. I hereby appoint my sister, Catherine M. Watkins to be the executrix under this, my last will and testament and request that she serve without bond.
