Q. And so since February 24, 1955 you have had personal knowledge of the ownership of that property by Dr. Charles H. Conley. Is that correct?

A. That is right.

Q. Mr. Rothenhoefer, in connection with your survey of the adjacent properties to the Conley lot in February 24, 1955, did you prepare a plat in connection with that?

A. Yes, I did. Well it is a surveyor's sketch.

Q. And this is a copy of the surveyor's sketch that I have just handed you. Is that correct?

A. That is right.

Q. Showing the adjacent properties and the Conley property?

A. That is right. I don't call for the Conley property, but the iron pipe and stone at Woods Road was the corner of his property.

Q. And this was prepared February 24, 1955?

A. That is correct.

By Mr. Bower: I would like to submit this as Complainant's Exhibit No. 2 at this time.

Q. Mr. Rothenhoefer, in connection with the preparation of the field survey of this property, did you also have an opportunity to examine the land records of Frederick County, Maryland in regards to the property previously owned by Charles H. Conley and now owned by Kenneth R. Rice and Mary Jane Rice, his wife?

A. Yes.

Q. And I believe that the records indicate that this property was conveyed to Millard F. McBride and wife by deed from John L. and Mary C. Hargett, dated March 24, 1894 and recorded in Liber LJ5, Folio 631. Is that correct?

A. That is correct?

Q. And you have copies of those records in your notes?

A. Yes, I do.
