

1 Q. Uh huh?

2 A. His second wife lived there. And, of course, the son
3 had moved into Frederick.

7 that you know possessed the part of this land that Mr. Lee
8 kept for himself?

9 A. Other than the Harrises, the Hamiltons, and the Hawkins.

10 Q. Now, I refer you to the, to this map that Mr. Roberts
11 pointed out and we see a piece of land here marked .736
12 acres and it appears to be a building thereon, it says
13 something like frame building or something thereon, is this
14 the location of the property that Mr. Lee was on at the time
15 he died?

16 A. Yes. This is part of the original plot, the whole big
17 plot. Now, I might add exceptions, you may object to this.

18 Q. No, that's okay go right ahead.

19 A. I might add exceptions that on the back of this land
20 up here.

21 Q. By what would be the Rosencrantz property?

22 A. Close to the Rosencrantz property from the John W. Lee
23 property over to the...
