FOURTH: That the nineteen acre parcel of land described in paragraph First herein is a part of the real estate described and conveyed in a deed from Mattie M. Jamison and John C. Jamison, her husband, unto John C. Stup and L. Olive Stup, his wife, dated April 15, 1942 and recorded in Liber 434, folio 14, one of said land records, a certified copy of said deed being filed herewith marked Exhibit #5, and prayed to be incorporated herein.

FIFTH: That said parcel of land is a part of the real estate described and conveyed in a deed from Fannie C. Burdette and Ira Lansdale Burdette, her husband, unto Mattie M. Jamison, dated August 16, 1941, and recorded in Liber 430, folio 207, one of said land records, a certified copy of said deed being filed herewith marked Exhibit #6, and prayed to be incorporated herein.

SIXTH: That said property is a part of the real estate described and conveyed in a deed from Virginia B. Brandenburg and Arnold Brandenburg, her husband, unto Fannie C. Burdette and Ira Lansdale Burdette, her husband, dated April 15, 1941 and recorded in Liber 430, folio 206, one of said land records, a certified copy of said deed being filed herewith marked Exhibit #7, and prayed to be incorporated herein, said deed reciting that Fannie C. Burdette and Virginia B. Brandenburg are the only surviving heirs (daughters) of one Etta Cutsail, who died intestate, seized and possessed of the above described real estate, a copy of the Inventory of Real Estate of the said Etta Cutsail, recorded in Liber R.L.L. 1, folio 18, one of the Will Records of Frederick County, Maryland, a certified copy thereof being filed herewith marked Exhibit #8, and prayed to be incorporated herein.
