being first duly sworn, testified on his oath as follows:

EXAMINATION

BY MR. GASTLEY:

Q. Would you state your name, age and residence?

A. Wilbur W. Gladhill, I am 62 years old and I live at Route 2, Myersville-Harmony Road, Myersville, Maryland.

Q. Mr. Gladhill you are restricted to your home because of your health, is this correct?

A. Yes. I do not go out very much at all due to my health. I do go out occasionally but I don't go very far and not very often. My doctor even comes here to the house to examine me as he won't let me come in to his office as he doesn't want me traveling any more than I have to.

Q. Mr. Gladhill, concerning Melvin O. Gladhill and Mary E. Gladhill, who were they?

A. They were my parents.

Q. They are deceased, is that correct?

A. Yes.

Q. Do you know Charles Edward Walter?

A. Yes I knew Mr. Walter and I also knew his father, William Walter.

Q. Concerning this particular case we are dealing with Lot 6 described as 12 acres 1 rood owned by Lewis N. Baker, did you know him?

A. Yes. I was a young boy at the time, however, I do remember him.

Q. Your father, Melvin O. Gladhill, bought this property from Mr. Baker, is that correct?

A. Yes.

Q. Do you know how long he owned this property?

A. I don't remember when he bought it but I remember when Mr. Baker owned it as when I was younger he would drag lumber down the mountain on his back and then my father would haul it down for him when he got up in years and could not do it on his own.

Q. Mr. Baker owned the property for some years prior to selling it to your father then?

A. Yes.
