REPORT OF SALE

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Report of Sale of Clater W. Smith, Jr., Successor Trustee in Deeds of Trust for the purpose of foreclosure in the above-entitled cause, respectfully shows:

FIRST: That on December 15, 1972, Thomas R. Bennett, II, executed ten Deeds of Trust to J. William Brosius and James McSherry conveying all that land designated herein as Parcels 1 thru 10, those being more particularly described in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and prayed to be made a part hereof.

SECOND: That said Deeds of Trust contained a provision that in case of default therein the trustee or its assignee would be authorized to exercise the power of sale in said Deeds of Trust as contained; that the said Thomas R. Bennett, II did default in the payment thereof, whereupon the Successor Trustee of said Deeds of Trust became empowered to exercise said power of sale and qualified by giving his bond to the State of Maryland, in the amount of Two Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$286,000.00), conditioned upon the faithful performance of his duties in the premises and advertised said real estate to be sold at public sale on December 13, 1977, at the Main Office (Administrative Building) of Lake Linganore at Eaglehead, Frederick County, Maryland, at the hour of 10:00 A.M. by advertisement inserted in The News and Post, at least once in each of three successive weeks, the first of said publications being not less than 15 days prior to sale and the last such publications being not more than one week prior to sale, it being a newspaper published in Frederick County, the Certificate of Pub-
