MOTION FOR DECREE PRO CONFESSO


Jamal Wafai K. Dajani, Plaintiff, by John H. Tisdale and Rollins, Price and Tisdale, his attorneys, moves, pursuant to Maryland Rule 310b for a decree pro confesso against Robert A. Marmet and Barbara D. Marmet, Defendants, for failure to comply with the requirement as to time for pleading in that the Bill of Complaint was served upon them 3 April 1978 and that the time for filing the answer thereto expired 2 June 1978 and that the answer has not been filed.

Robert A. Marmet, Defendant, is an attorney who has offices in Washington, D.C. In this matter he is acting as attorney for his wife. Mr. Marmet requested that process be served on him at his office address in Washington, D.C. That request was made by letter of 10 June 1977, which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

Mr. Marmet has received service of the Bill of Complaint and has notified the Plaintiff of the intent of the Defendants not to defend the suit. His acknowledgment of receipt of service and statement of intention not to defend is contained in his letter of 1 June 1978, which is attached hereto as Exhibit 2.

Neither Defendant, Robert A. Marmet or Barbara D. Marmet, is now in the service of the Armed Forces of the United States of America, nor of any nation allied with the United States of America.
