Schaeffer his wife, of Frederick City, Maryland, Witnesseth;- That for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Nine Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$2950.00) in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we the said Marshall E. Schaeffer and Annie E. Schaeffer, his wife, do hereby grant and convey unto Samuel E. Homer and Mary L. Homer, his wife, all that lot or parcel of ground situate, lying and being in Frederick City, Maryland, and known as No. 9, Train Avenue in said town and is the south side of Lot No. 14 which the said Marshall E. Schaeffer obtained by deed from George H. Zimmerman and wife, said deed bearing date November 13th 1909, and is recorded in Liber H.W.B. No. 296, Folio 508, one of the Land Records for Frederick County, said parcel of land being shown and described in the Plat of Frederick City Manufacturing and Development Company Northwest Addition to Frederick Maryland, recorded in Liber W.I.P.
