FIFTH: That your Affiant has taken all other steps known to locate the said Louis J. Glass and Ellsworth Steinberg, their heirs, successors and/or assigns, the only evidence having been adduced being that both of these parties are believed to be dead.

SIXTH: That your Affiant has made all reasonable efforts to locate the said Louis J. Glass and Ellsworth Steinberg, their heirs, successors and/or assigns, in good faith, but has been unsuccessful in accomplishing same.

WHEREFORE, your Affiant prays that this Court issue an Order directing that service of process of the Bill of Complaint for Release of Mortgage be made against the said Louis J. Glass and Ellsworth Steinberg, their heirs, successors and/or assigns, by posting a copy of the Order of Publication at the Court House door and on the subject property, pursuant to Maryland Rule 105 and Maryland Rule 111.
