ORDER OF PUBLICATION

This is to give notice that on the 5th day of April, 1978, a Complaint was filed in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, by the Plaintiff against the Defendant, whose last known address was Suite 520, Shoreham Building, Washington, D. C. The Petition alleges in substance that Plaintiff is the owner of certain real property in the Urbana Election District of Frederick County, Maryland; that she and Jacob M. Johnson, now deceased, executed a mortgage to Wilfred Hooe and Laura Jane Hooe, who assigned same to the Defendant; that although the debt secured has been paid, Defendant failed to release the mortgage, wherefore a cloud on title exists.

The relief prayed in the Complaint is substantially as follows:

Plaintiff prays this Court to remove the cloud on title by declaring the mortgage null and void and of no further force or effect and enjoin the Defendant, his heirs and assigns from enforcing the mortgage.

WHEREUPON, it is ordered by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, this 5th day of April, 1978, that Plaintiff cause a copy of this Order to be inserted in a newspaper published in Frederick County, Maryland, once a week in each of three successive weeks, before the 2nd day of May, 1978, giving notice to the said Defendant of the object and substance of the Petition and warning him to Show Cause, on or before the 1st day of June, 1978, why a decree should not be passed as prayed.
