

The Bill states, among other things, that the amounts necessary for redemption have not been paid, although more than a year from the date of sale has expired.

It is thereupon this 17th day of August, 1978, by the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Frederick County, ORDERED that the Complainant give notice of this proceeding by mailing a copy of this Order of Publication to the Respondents, Jean Allison, Calvin Howard Lawson, Sarah Gilbert, Clarence Edward Lawson, Jr. at their last known address, and that the Sheriff post a copy of this Order of Publication at the Court House door, or on a bulletin Board in the immediate vicinity thereof, warning all persons interested in the said property to be and appear in the Court by the 20th day of October, 1978, and redeem the property and answer the Bill of Complaint or thereafter a final decree will be rendered foreclosing all rights of redemption in the property, investing in the Complainant a title, free and clear of all encumbrances.
