PARCEL NO. 1: ALL that lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the City of Frederick, Frederick County, State of Maryland, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEING located on the north side of East Patrick Street in Frederick, Frederick County, Maryland, and being a part of Lot No. 50 on the original plat of Frederick, improved with a three-story brick dwelling known as 125 East Patrick Street, and fronting between 31 1/2 feet, more or less, and running back an even width a depth of 186 feet, more or less.

TOGETHER with the right-of-way to the aforesaid property extending from the alley between Patrick and Church Streets, as set forth in an Indenture by and between John J. Boyd, Horace Woodward, William S. Anderson, and A.G. Quynn, dated May 19, 1953 and recorded in Liber E.S.
