

Order of Court fixing amount
 necessary for redemption of
 certain property.

The petition of Francis Leo Steiner, and exhibits, as well as the other proceedings in this cause, having been read and considered by the Court, and it appearing that said petitioner is the owner of certain lots mentioned in these proceedings, and desires to redeem said lots from said tax sales, and is ready to pay the amount to be fixed by the Court for their redemption;

It is thereupon, this 8th day of March, 1946, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting in Equity, and by the authority thereof adjudged and ordered that the amount necessary for the redemption of the lots mentioned in the foregoing petition, Lots No. 2 and 9 on Maryland, Avenue; Lots No. 51, 62 and 64 on Middle Street; and Lots No. 90, 105 and 106, on Brunswick Street, assessed in the name of the petitioner, be and is hereby fixed at Fifty nine and
95/100 dollars, (\$59. $\frac{95}{100}$) and that upon the payment of said sum of money to the Collector of Taxes for Frederick County, who shall disburse the same according to law, and that the complainant shall dismiss the proceedings as to the 1 lots mentioned above.
