

Third: Swastika Road, fifty feet in width; from its southern limits to Lindbergh Avenue Beginning at a point on the east side of Swastika road and the south side of a 16.0 foot alley, said point also being on the northeast corner of Lot #12 as shown on said plat and thence running the following courses and distances:

(1) S 51° - 30' W. 128.60 feet to the Point of Curve, thence measured along the curve 269.22 feet to intersect the east line of Lindbergh Avenue, thence along the east side of Lindbergh Avenue (2) N. 38° - 00' E. 88.5 feet to the West side of Swastika Road, thence along the west side of Swastika Road measured on the curve (3) 162.0 feet to the Point of Curve thence (4) N. 51° -30' E. 139.5 feet to a point on the north side of Swastika Road, thence S. 38° 30' E. 50.0 feet to the place of beginning.

Fourth: A triangular parcel of real estate situated between Swastika Road and Lindbergh Avenue, and designated "Park" on said plat,

Beginning at the intersection of the east line Lindbergh Avenue and the west line of Swastika Road and running thence the following courses and distances,

(1) N 38° -00' E- 151.0 feet to a point, thence (2) S. 52° -30' E- 57.5 feet to the west line of Swastika road, thence by and with the west line of Swastika Road measured along the curve 162.0 feet to the place of beginning.
