TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The bill of complaint of Eliza P. Johnson and Lawson Johnson, her husband, of Frederick County, Maryland, respectfully represents:

1. That a certain Michael E. Gordon, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, departed this life, intestate, on or about the 8th day of October, 1928, seized and possessed of all that lot of land, in the village of Petersville, in said Frederick County, Maryland, containing one acre, one rood and twenty-seven square perches of land, more or less, and bounded as follows:

Beginning at a stone planted at the end of the second line of Lot No. 6, on the plat of the "Resurvey on Maryland", said point being at the beginning of Lot No. 8, on said plat, and running thence, with the first line of said Lot No. 8, South 30° East, 14.04 perches to the northeast corner of Peter Jackson's Lot, and with said lot two courses and distances,
