The Bill of Complaint of John R. Foreman, Jr. and Mildred E. Foreman,  
his wife, by David E. Aldridge, their solicitor, respectfully represents  
unto this Honorable Court:

FIRST: That they have possessed and held that certain lot or parcel  
of ground, containing one-half acre, more or less, known as 9229  
Fingerboard Road, Ijamsville, Maryland 21754, under a claim of title by  
virtue of a deed dated November 11, 1959 and recorded among the Land  
Records of Frederick County, Maryland in Liber No. 630, folio 527 from the  
heirs of Frank Fisher to John R. Foreman, Jr. and Mildred E. Foreman, his  
wife, the Complainants herein, a certified copy of the aforesaid deed  
being attached herewith as Exhibit "A" and prayed to be taken and made a  
part hereof.

SECOND: That the said Frank Fisher acquired fee simple title to the  
lot or parcel in question by deed dated June 13, 1876 and recorded among  
the aforesaid Land Records in Liber TG No. 5, folio 508 from Sebastian G.
