GRACE I. E. PURDUM, ET AL

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN:

I, Eutaw M. Snook, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, and being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me heretofore made.

1st ITEM: First and Principally, I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors, and my will is that all of my just debts and funeral expenses shall be paid as soon after my decease as may be convenient.

2nd ITEM: I give and bequeath unto my niece, Grace I. E. Purdum, all of my Personal Property, inside and outside of house other than the Blacksmith tools and skill saw and other items of similar nature, which I give and bequeath unto my brother, Josiah Snook.

3rd ITEM: I give, devise, and bequeath all of my real estate, in Mountindale, Lewistown Election District, Frederick County, Maryland, or wheresoever situate, unto my niece, Grace I. E. Purdum, for and during her natural lifetime.

4th ITEM: I give and bequeath unto my niece, Grace I. E. Purdum, a life estate in the home property upon the condition that Josiah Snook, my brother, may continue to make his home there as long as he shall live or desire to do so.

5th ITEM: I give and bequeath unto my niece, Grace I. E. Purdum, the interest to money in bank or any securities I may have during her natural lifetime, and no longer, but, if she shall become in state of bad health or emergency, or absolute need, my Executors, in their discretion, may withdraw from her said share or corpus, proper portion or portions thereof and pay same over to her.

6th ITEM: I give and bequeath the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) to the Lewistown Cemetery Association, Inc., upon the condition that same will be used for the perpetual care of the Snook burial lot.

7th ITEM: I have a brother, William Snook, who resides at Lamar, Missouri, and I feel and believe that he is able to care for himself.

8th ITEM: Upon the death of my niece, Grace I. E. Purdum, I direct that all the rest and residue of my estate, real, personal, or mixed, be converted into cash and distributed as follows: one-third unto the surviving children of Hazel Lewis, a niece, one-third share unto the surviving children of my brother, Josiah Snook, and the remaining one-third share unto the surviving children of my niece, Grace I. E. Purdum, share and share alike.

ALL THE REST AND RESIDUE of my estate and property, I give, devise, and bequeath to the persons herein specified and in the manner and proportions and conditions herein specified.

AND LASTLY, I hereby nominate, constitute, and appoint my niece, Grace I. E. Purdum and Calvin Lohr, Executors of this my Last Will and Testament, without bond, and with full power to sell or do any act to carry out the intent of this Will.
