2 HEARING EXAMINER STILLRICH: So entered.

3 (The document referred to,  
4 heretofore marked Complainants'  
5 Exhibit No. 8 for identification,  
6 was received in evidence.)

7 BY MR. DE MOLL:

8 Q. Go on.

9 A. Then they conveyed, Eutaw M. Snook, executor, and  
10 Lottie M. Snook made a straw conveyance to Helen Mock in liber  
11 444 at 595, dated September 1st, 1944, and recorded January  
12 11th, 1945.

13 Then Helen conveyed back into Eutaw and Lottie Snook  
14 at liber 444, folio 596, approximately five acres, three roods,  
15 10 square perches, dated September 1st, 1944, and recorded  
16 January 11th, 1945, making it a joint tenancy.

17 Q. What has been marked as Complainants' Exhibit Number  
18 9, is this the deed you just spoke of?

19 A. Yes, it is.

20 Q. How many acres did that deed contain?

21 A. Okay, this contains approximately five acres, three  
22 roods, 10 square perches.

23 It mentions it was out of the original nine acres,  
24 three roods, 10 square perches, less the conveyance to Josiah  
25 Snook, and less the conveyance to Fogle. Then it goes on,
