

31. The Charter of Point-of-Rocks Estates, Inc., was annulled on or about October 30, 1969. (Ex. 13)

32. Officers and Directors of Point-of-Rocks Estates, Inc., as of October 30, 1969, (the date of annulment of its charter), were Ralph Yarnick, President, Eleanor Yarnick, Secretary and Treasurer, and James Pappas, Vice President. Their addresses were listed as Point of Rocks, Maryland. Ralph Yarnick, of Kings Hill Road, Germantown, Maryland, was the last designated resident agent.

33. Research indicates Point-of-Rocks never entered into a bankruptcy proceeding, nor any insolvency proceedings.

34. In Equity No. 22,914, Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, (the Trustees' sale), the following efforts were made to notify the successors in interest of Point-of-Rocks of such action.

a) Notice dated November 20, 1970, to Point-of-Rocks Estates, Inc., Mr. Ralph Yarnick, Resident Agent, Point-of-Rocks, Maryland 21777 (signed for by Jerry Yarnick).

b) Notice to Ralph and Eleanor Yarnick, dated November 20, 1970, to Point-of-Rocks Estates, (signed for by Jerry Yarnick).

c) Arthur J. Campbell, Jr., Esquire, of 22 West Second Street, Frederick, Maryland 21701, excepted to the original Trustees' sale proceedings on behalf of Respondents Yarnick, et al (October 14, 1970). (Exceptions were sustained because of failure to give notice to Respondent, Point-of-Rocks Estates, Inc.)

d) Subsequent Trustees' sale proceedings were ratified by this Court.

35. A similar pattern is presented in Equity No. 22,931, Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland.
