2. An Answer to the Plaintiff's Complaint has been filed by The Board of Education. The Defendant, The Board of Education, filed an Answer requesting that it be dismissed from the case. The Board of Education has further consented to the relief requested by the Plaintiff by the express consent of the said Defendant as indicated by the signature of its attorney, Tod P. Salisbury, attached to this Motion.

3. An Order of Default was entered on March 24, 1988, against all Defendants named as failing to appear.

4. Attached to this Motion for Summary Judgment is the supporting Affidavit of Plaintiff, Adrian Elizabeth Lyles. That in said Affidavit Plaintiff incorporates and verifies all of the matters alleged in the Plaintiff's Complaint, which matters establish a prima facie case for title by adverse possession of the subject property. Said Affidavit is hereby incorporated in this Motion by reference.

5. As of the date of the filing of this Motion no persons or other entities have responded to the Plaintiff's Complaint as an interested person, by reason of the Notice of the action which is posted near the Court House door on a bulletin board as set forth above. The deadline for any such interested persons to file an Answer to the Complaint was February 29, 1988. Such date has passed with no objections being made by anyone to the relief requested by the Plaintiff.
