for the period of time. The same procedure would be necessary for all of the Sherrifs of Frederick County. This procedure, to my knowledge, has never ever been attempted. The other problem you have when you try to bring a property forward is property owners dying and heirs taking title. The new law in 1971, which establishes Personal Representatives is a great help but does not solve the problem of prior estates and heirs. With all of these problems in mind, I did attempt to bring forward this portion of the missing property. I was able to trace this 46+ acres from the old survey record forward to 10-11-1843, to a deed into John Dorsey in H.S. 20/470. I tried to trace it forward but lost it. I ran John Dorsey in the indexes thru 5-17-1915 and found no clue as to where this land went. This result is exactly as I expected. At this point I am out of ideas as what else may be tried in order to solve this mystery.

I am sorry that my efforts did not produce a positive result, but that is the realm of probability when undertaking a task of this nature. I will be glad to go over all of the things that I did and explain them to you if you have any questions.
