AGREEMENT OF SEPARATION

THIS AGREEMENT, made in duplicate this 24<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1956, by and between John G. Droneburg, of Frederick, Maryland, and Marie K. Droneburg, of Frederick, Maryland,

WITNESSETH: Whereas differences have arisen between the said parties, John G. Droneburg and Marie K. Droneburg, in consequence of which they are living separate and apart; and with a view to this change in their relations they desire to enter into an arrangement as to their personal and property rights issuing from the marriage of the parties to this agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH:

That all covenants hereinafter contained are made on behalf of said parties, and their respective heirs, personal representatives and assigns.

That the said parties, in consideration of their mutual agreements hereinafter contained, may at all times hereafter live separate and apart from each other and free from any authority of one over the other.

FIRST: That the said Marie K. Droneburg, party of the first part, in consideration of the premises, and of the covenants on the part of the said John G. Droneburg, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, agrees as follows:

1. That the said John G. Droneburg may at all times hereafter live separate and apart from the said Marie K. Droneburg, and free from her authority and control, and that she, the said Marie K. Droneburg, will not endeavor to compel the said John G. Droneburg to cohabit with her, or use any violence or restraint upon his person, or molest him in his way of living, or interfere with him or his liberty, or prosecute any person for receiving or assisting him or for having been instrumental in bringing about this separation.

2. That all property of the said John G. Droneburg real and personal, now held by him absolutely, or subject to the marriage rights of the said Marie K. Droneburg, or which shall in any manner devolve on him, or be acquired by him, shall be his sole
