Disbursements by reason of this Audit amount to \$266.00, leaving a balance of \$13,908.42 in the hands of the Committee. This amount is distributed to Ina M. Dennison who has been qualified in the Orphans' Court for Allegany County, Maryland, as the Personal Representative of Martha Grace Skelley, the incompetent, and now deceased.
