Congregation of the Trinity African Methodist Episcopal Church
 of Baltimore City State of Maryland held at 8:30 P.M. February
 25. 1855 at the usual place of said congregation said meeting having
 been called for this purpose according to the usages of the Church and said
 congregation consisting of those persons having the management of the
 congregational and temporal affairs of the Church a Majority of whom
 was not twenty one years of age and citizens of the State of Maryland
 and of the United States John Collett presiding and John H. Washington
 acting as Secretary the following plan and agreement for the govern-
 ment of said Church was adopted. Whereas it is desirable that the
 Justices of Trinity African Methodist Episcopal Church of Baltimore
 County at the City of Baltimore State of Maryland should have the
 right to acquire and hold property for the use of said Church in
 accordance with the law of said State as set forth in Article 40 Section
 15 of said State and such amendments or additions as may be made
 from time to time and Whereas for said purposes it is necessary
 that certain Justices should be elected and certain proceedings should
 be had with a view to constituting said Justices a body politic or
 corporation under the law of the State of Maryland therefore be it
 resolved that this Church Society or congregation shall be known as
 Trinity African Methodist Episcopal Church of Baltimore City Mary-
 land and be it further resolved that there shall be a board of Justices
 of said Church to consist of four (4) persons by choice of the Minister
 here by the law of Maryland required by virtue of his Ministry to
 be a member of said board of Justices each of said four Justices to be not
 less than twenty one years of age and a Majority of whom shall be
 members of the African Methodist Episcopal Church and be it further
