and ten o'clock of the day aforesaid, We opened the polls
in the City aforesaid, for the purpose of electing two persons
to represent the City of Annapolis in the General assembly
of Maryland, that we continued the same open until
closed by Consent - the ballot box being opened, and
the ballots publicly counted, when it appeared that
Arthur Shaaff ————— had one hundred and forty
five ————— votes, that John Mui —————
had one hundred and forty three ————— votes ~~and that John~~
Lynn ————— ~~had~~ had fifty one votes,
Archibald Shaaff had one vote, John Shaaff had one
vote, John Mumroe had one vote, and John Brewer
had one vote, as Delegates to the General assembly
of Maryland - Given under our hands at the place
of said election this fifth day of October eighteen
hundred and five.
